

Commercial Drivers License 'B '(All year round)

A copy of Learners Permit and D.O.T. Physical card are required before making an appointment with the Training School.

(16 hours training)

Training will consist of learning what to say and do on the walk around part of the test and some driving time on the road with the truck

Forklift Certification (All year round)

(4 hours of classroom and a practical test)

In accordance with OSHA 1910.178 all forklift operators are required to be trained and certified. In order to receive this certification you must attend class and pass a written and practical test.

Forklift Recertification-REQUIRED EVERY THREE YEARS

(NO GRACE PERIOD/NO EXEPTIONS) (All year round)

(4 hours of classroom)

Federal OSHA requires that all certified forklift operators be evaluated every three years. YOU MUST ATTEND A 4-HOUR CLASS AND PASS A WRITTEN TEST BEFORE THE EXPERATION DATE OF YOUR CURRENT CERTIFICATION OR YOU WILL NEED TO TAKE THE PRACTICAL EXAM AGAIN.NO EXCEPTIONS.

PIPELINE OPERATOR QUALIFICATION-REQUIRED EVERY 3 YEARS. (All year round as needed)

(6 hours of classroom)

New D.O.T. requirements call for the operators employed in either gas transmission or distribution work to be evaluated on 11 covered tasks relating to this industry. This is not a test of operating ability.

Some of the pipeline contractors are requiring this certification regardless of the type of pipe they are using.

Transportation Workers Identification Card (T.W.I.C.)

This is a credential that allows workers unescorted access to secure areas of MTSA (Maritime Transportation Security Act) regulated facilities.

HAZMAT-40 HOUR CERTIFICATION (Winter months or as need arises)

(40 hours classroom and hands on)

This certification is specifically designed for workers in accordance with OSHA at 29 CFR 1910.120. This training is required for Superfund work.

HAZMAT RECERTIFICATION (January, February, March)

(8 hours classroom)

A mandatory annual course for maintaining a valid Hazmat OSHA approved certificate.

OSHA 10-HOUR COURSE (All year round as needed)

This is a safety course designed to help identify the common causes of accidents on the work site. It will make the worker aware of how to recognize and alleviate hazards on the job site.

RIGGING AND SIGNALING (All year round as needed)

Federally mandated as of November 8, 2010

(8 hours classroom)

A basic rigging course for journey persons involved in rigging and signaling cranes. Some of the topics include lifting devices, rigging standards, slings, chains, wire rope, and sling angles. A qualification card will be issued upon completion.

FIRST AID/CPR (All year round as needed)

(8 hours classroom and hands on)

This course provides First Aid and C.P.R. training.

MINE SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (As needed)

(24 hours classroom)

Construction, Metal/Non – Metal & Surface Mines

This certification is in accordance with MSHA 30 CFR Part 46. OSHA 29 CFR1910 And OSHA 1926.

The course covers health and safety issues on the work site and in particular hazards that are site specific to mines.

MINE SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION-REFRESHER (Yearly)

(8 hours classroom)

The annual refresher training must be completed no later than 12 months from the expiration date on the card.
